

## Hannibal Piecemakers Quilt Guild “Threads of Time” Quilt Show 2024

1. Quilt submission form must be filled out completely to be eligible for entry by Friday, March 1, 2024.
2. Quilt must be clean and of good quality. Incomplete, torn, or soiled quilts do not qualify for entry or display and will be rejected.
3. The Quilt Acquisition Committee reserves the right to refuse the display of distasteful items.
4. Quilts do not have to be appraised to be entered.
5. Hannibal Piecemakers Quilt Guild (HPQG) will not provide insurance for your quilt. That is the owner's responsibility. However, the building will not be unattended at any time from the time it is dropped off until it is picked up. Security will be provided.
6. HPQG will make every effort to handle your quilts with the utmost of care. However, we will NOT be able to provide any special handling of quilts such as those with embellishments that require them to be hung and packaged in a certain manner. Thank you for understanding.
7. An attached label is required on the back of every quilt. If your quilt is being judged, please safety pin an opaque fabric or place blue painters tape over the label before dropping off quilt. Covering may be removed after judging.
8. All quilts smaller than 46" in width will be required to have a sleeve that is a minimum of 2" in width (sleeve may be temporarily basted on). No exceptions. Any quilt 46" or larger must have a piece of white fabric that is at least 3" x 5" with the word “TOP” and is sewn to the top center of the quilt. No safety pins, straight pins, or tape is to be used in attaching the piece of fabric to the quilt. Any quilt submitted without the hanging sleeve or sign attached to the quilt at the time of drop off will be rejected.
9. Multiple entries may be made by one person; however, see category limits. The electronic entry form is located at <http://hannibalpiecemakers.com/>. A photo of each quilt is required and must be uploaded when entering electronically. Paper entry forms are available upon request and may be copied for multiple entries.
10. There is no fee for entering your quilts unless you want them judged. Judged entries can be submitted electronically but will not be entered into the judged category until payment is received. Entry fees are \$20 per quilt for non-members and \$10 per quilt for members. Juniors entering their quilts in the Junior category, may have their quilts judged at no cost. Multiple judged quilts may be payable with one check.
11. Judged entry fee refunds prior to the entry deadline are at the discretion of the Acquisition Committee. Judged entry fees are non-refundable after March 1.
12. All Quilts are required to be checked in during drop-off times. Quilt will be examined prior to acceptance. Please plan accordingly. NO Exceptions.
13. No unaccompanied drop-off of quilts.
14. Quilt pick-up for non-members will begin at 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 6, 2024.  
NON-MEMBERS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING DURING TEARDOWN.  
No Exceptions. Quilt pick-up for HPQG members will begin after teardown is completed on Saturday, April 6, 2024.  
**Receipt is required for quilt pick-up for both Members and Non-Members.**

**CATEGORIES** – Choose your category carefully. For example: If you choose the Machine Quilted category, the quilt will be judged primarily on machine quilting. **Limit of 3 quilts per person per category for non-members.** Quilts will NOT be moved to the appropriate category. Entries may be any size but must include top, batting and backing. Perimeter is calculated by adding the length and width and taking that answer times 2.

**Viewer's Choice** – 1<sup>st</sup> place ribbons will be awarded in each of the following categories unless otherwise noted:

- a. Viewer's Choice – The viewer's favorite quilt overall.
- b. Large Bed Quilts (  $\geq 280$ " perimeter )
- c. Wall Quilts (  $\geq 160$ " and  $< 280$ " perimeter)
- d. Small Quilts (  $< 160$ " perimeter )
- e. Miniatures – Entry may be maximum 96" perimeter or smaller. All aspects of the quilt are reduced in scale.
- f. Art – Entry may be any size of your original design made with artistic intent that uses color, design, and construction techniques to create a work that expands beyond traditional quilts. **An original work is composed first-hand – a fresh design or style without copying the works of others. NO KITS or COMMERCIAL PATTERNS.**
- g. Juniors – Entry must be constructed by youth under 18 years old.
- h. Men's quilts – Entry must be constructed by a male.
- i. Theme ("Threads of Time"). Entry may be any size.

**Judged Entries** – Prize money will be awarded to the Judge's Choice--Best of Show, 1<sup>st</sup> place winners and will be determined by number of entries. Entry fee is \$10 for HPQG members, \$20 for non-members per judged entry with the exception of entries made into the Junior category. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place ribbons will be awarded in each of the following categories unless otherwise noted:

- a. Judge's Choice--Best of Show
- b. Large Bed Quilts (  $\geq 280$ " perimeter )
  1. Pieced – Entry must be more than 50% pieced.
  2. Hand Appliquéd – Entry must be more than 50% hand appliquéd.
  3. Machine Appliquéd – Entry must be more than 50% machine appliquéd.
  4. Hand Quilted – Entry must be 100% hand quilted.
  5. Machine Quilted – Entry must be 100% machine quilted.
  6. Hand Embroidery
  7. Machine Embroidery
- c. Wall Quilts (  $\geq 160$ " and  $< 280$ " perimeter)
  1. Pieced – Entry must be more than 50% pieced.
  2. Hand Appliquéd – Entry must be more than 50% hand appliquéd.
  3. Machine Appliquéd – Entry must be more than 50% machine appliquéd.
  4. Hand Quilted – Entry must be 100% hand quilted.
  5. Machine Quilted – Entry must be 100% machine quilted.
  6. Hand Embroidery
  7. Machine Embroidery
- d. Small Quilts (  $< 160$ " perimeter )
- e. Miniatures – Entry may be maximum 96" perimeter or smaller. **ALL ASPECTS** of the quilt are reduced in scale.
- f. Art – Entry may be any size of your original design made with artistic intent that uses color, design, and construction techniques to create a work that expands beyond traditional quilts. **An original work is composed first-hand – a fresh design or style without copying the works of others. NO KITS or COMMERCIAL PATTERNS.**
- g. Juniors – Entry must be constructed by youth under 18 years old.
- h. Men's quilts – Entry must be constructed by a male.
- i. Theme ("Threads of Time"). Entry may be any size.
