JULY CHALLENGE - ROUND ROBIN

- It's optional - only play if you really want to and are prepared to stick to the schedule.
- Pick a group of 3 or 4 people. Make a list with the people in your group (could be people at your table, people that want to use the same fabrics).
- Each person starts by making a center block of your choice. Most do a 12" to 16" block.
- Each person puts together a small fabric of colors you like (maybe left over from your center).
- Each person writes a note stating what they would like to end up with (table runner, wall hanging). Write your likes or dislikes, put all this with your center block and fabrics to pass to the next person in your group.
- Bring your bag into the March meeting to pass to someone in your group.
- Each person has a month to add a round or border to the quilt. Then it will be passed to another person in the group.
- There will be 2 months for the last round, as it will be bigger.
- Don't let anyone see what they look like. Bring the top in for the big reveal in July, when it is given back to the person who made the center block.
