Please include copy of appraisal with quilt entry to ensure total appraisal amount to be covered by HPQG insurance. Without appraisal, up to \$300 coverage per quilt will be included in case of loss or damages. HPQG will handle all entries with great care and will supervise guests. Your signature below acknowledges your recognition and assumption of risk.

I agree to accept the terms of this waiver for HPQG to insure my quilt for the item’s appraisal amount or up to \$300 (without appraisal document).
