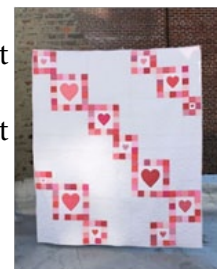

FEBRUARY 21 WORKSHOP

STRATA BLOCK SUE WINKING

Beacon United Methodist Church
9 a.m. – 3 p.m.

We will be working on the Strata block from Moonkin Stitchery. You will need a layer cake or jelly roll with 42 pieces as well as 2 accent colors in solid to coordinate with your fabric, you will need 1/2 yard of each color. The quilt comes out to 56" x 69" in a 7 x 6 layout.

Cut your accent fabrics into 42 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" pieces each.

Cut the layer cake or jelly roll into 2 1/2" x 10" strips.

This picture shows 4 blocks of the layout.

Come have a fun day sewing with fellow members.

**ANNOUNCING THE HPQG
2026 SERIES QUILT
LAURA'S LOG CABIN BY MODERN PRAIRIE**

This quilt is made of only two blocks: a log cabin block and a star block.

Blocks measure 11 ¾" square.

Scant ¼" seams are used for construction.

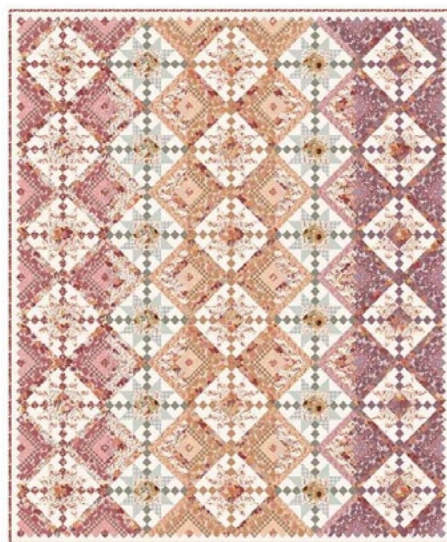
THE LABELED & COLOR-CODED CHART ON PAGE 13 IS VERY HELPFUL FOR UNDERSTANDING BLOCK & COLOR PLACEMENT.

January Assignment: Fabric selection.

- Select 28 fabrics. Attach swatches of your selected fabrics over the fabric pics in the pattern.

February Assignment: Cutting the fabric. Be sure to use the fabric labels we have provided. Label everything as you cut, according to the directions!

- Cut fabrics listed on pages 1 and 2 of the pattern.
- Cut fabrics listed on pages 3 of the pattern.
- Cut fabrics listed on page 4 of the pattern.



If anyone needs a paper copy of the fabric labels, schedule for the year, or other documents, please let us know. There are links to each document on the HPQG facebook page, but we can get paper copies for members if that is needed.
