**FEBRUARY 20, 9-3**

You will need 5  
fabrics--

1 dark, 2 medium and 2 light.  
Depending on how big you make the  
strips, you will need 1/2 yard to a yard  
of each color. The sample is made  
with 1 1/4" strips. If you choose to make  
the strips bigger, you will need the  
larger amount of yardage. You will  
be making 5 different blocks that fit  
together to make the quilt design.  
March 20--Table Runner, taught  
by Rita Lentz. It is a Hexagon Braid  
pattern and done with 5" squares.

on February 2, prior to the monthly  
guild meeting.
