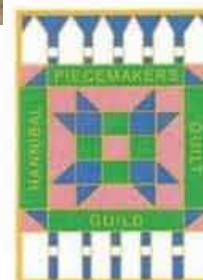

WORKSHOP MARCH 21

What's In Your Bag?



Fabric Requirements for TWO bags:

- 2 fat quarters of coordinating fabrics (or you may use up to 4 fabrics)
 - ¼ yard of fusible fleece
 - 2 -- 14" zippers
 - 2 -- 4" x 6 ½" pieces of heavy vinyl
- (I will provide the vinyl.)**

If you want to cut your fabrics in advance cut the following if you want to make TWO bags:

MAIN FABRIC

- 2 -- 8" x 9½" -- Back of bag
- 2 -- 6" x 9½" -- Bottom of window
- 2 -- 4" x 9½" -- Top of window (or could use fabric 3)
- 4 -- 4" x 4" -- Sides of window (or could use fabric 4)
- 2 -- 2¼" x 12" -- Handle
- 2 -- 1½" x 4" -- Zipper end cover

LINING FABRIC

- 2 -- 8" x 9½" Rectangle

FUSIBLE FLEECE

- 2 -- 8" x 9½" -- Back of bag
- 4 -- 1½" x 4" -- Side of bag
- 2 -- 1½" x 9¼" -- Top of bag
- 2 -- 2½" x 9¼" -- Bottom of bag
