Quilt Show

A big thank you to all those who entered quilts. Make sure your quilts are clean and free of any animal hair.

All quilts will be required to have a sleeve (sleeve may be temporarily basted on). Quilts 60" and smaller will need a minimum 2" sleeve. Quilts over 60" will need a minimum 4 inch sleeve. No exceptions. All quilts must be able to be hung. Any quilt 80" or larger must have a hanging sleeve attached to the top of the quilt. OR A 5" x 7" piece of white fabric with the word "TOP" sewn to the top

center of the quilt. The lettering is to be 4 inches in height and in black lettering. No safety pins, straight pins, or tape is to be used in attaching the piece of fabric to the quilt. Any quilt submitted without the hanging sleeve or sign attached to the quilt at the time of drop off will be rejected..

Also, volunteers are needed for all aspects of the quilt show. All who volunteer and work will be entered into a drawing for the workers quilt.

All workshops are from 9-3 at the Park United Methodist Church, Cost is \$5 for members and \$10 for non-members.

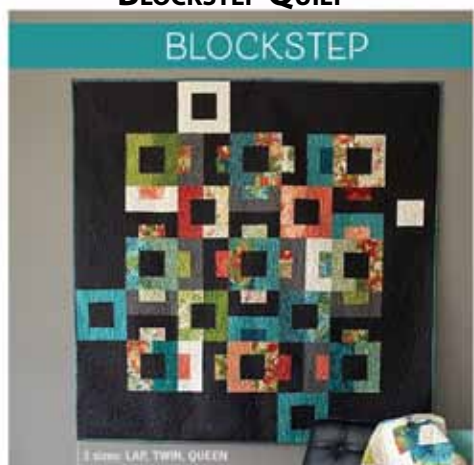
BLOCKSTEP QUILT

Blockstep is a pattern that plays with the geometry of squares by splitting and rotating them. A **Layer Cake** (or 2 for Queen size) of prints mix with 3 solid colors (I used Thatched!) Some blocks step out into the borders. **Blockstep** is shown using **Carolina Lilies** by Robin Pickens for Moda Fabrics. Pattern can also be made using a Jellyroll instead of Layer Cake.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS	Fabric Yardage based on quilting weight cotton with at least a 42" width.
WALL/LAP 56½" x 56½"	
Prints for blocks	1 Layer Cake/Jelly Roll (or use 2 Charm Packs)
3 Accent Colors (A, B, C)	1/3 yard each of 3 Accent Colors
Background	2 yd
Backing	3¾ yds
Binding	½ yard
TWIN 72½" x 88½"	
Prints for blocks	1 Layer Cake/Jelly Roll (or use 4 Charm Packs)
3 Accent Colors (A, B, C)	½ yard each of 3 Accent Colors
Background	3 1/3 yds
Backing	5 ½ yds
Binding	¾ yard
QUEEN 88½" x 88½"	
PRINTS for blocks	2 Layer Cakes/2 Jelly Rolls (or use 5 Charm Packs)
3 Accent Colors (A, B, C)	2/3 yard each of 3 Accent Colors
Background	3¾ yds
Backing	8 yds
Binding	1 yard
