SERIES QUILT 2022

Our 2022 Series Quilts promise to offer everyone some fun. I have chosen two projects which offer you flexibility and creativity as you would choose. If you want to simply follow the instructions or in one project buy a kit, you can. If you want a smaller version of the quilts, both have convenient ways to adjust the size to your liking.

The first project is called Ruby Sensations. This is a medallion quilt, meaning it is worked from the center block out, like a round robin. The quilt size is 86" X 86", however, you can stop at any point to make it smaller or add additional rounds to make it bigger. The center block also offers options. The pattern has a Missouri Star in the center, but a Carpenter's Star would also work if it measured the same. The pattern is available through Missouri Star



Company, and there are three color wave kits available. The second project is called Seminole Border Sampler. This quilt plays off the traditional Seminole Quilts and garments that the Florida Seminole Indians make. Their artwork is all by hand, with very tiny pieces. I have taken the time to increase the size of the Seminole strips to show the unique pieced borders that this beautiful technique to do for your quilts. The instructions for this project will come to you monthly since it is written by me. If you want to audition fabric, look for Light, Medium, and Dark fabrics with high contrast. You can make this in three colors (L/M/D) or scrappy. (I used a jelly roll plus yardage for mine). Instructions for both will be provided at the next meeting.

- One 100 foot bundle will make 2 medium sized bowls.
