The designer is giving us a VERY good deal on the pattern and kit and is paying the shipping. However, feel free to purchase your materials elsewhere. May 17 Workshop -- Applique

Beacon United Methodist Church (previously Park United) 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.

WORKSHOP PREP:

- I. FABRIC & Steam-a-Seam 2 (SAS)
 - A. FLOWER (4) 4" x 8" [make 12]
 - B. CALYX (6) 3" x 3" [make 12]
 - C. LEAF 1 (1) 2.5" x 12.5. [leaf (8)]
 - D. LEAF 2 (1) 3" x 20". [leaf (8)]
 - E. CORNER (1) 6.5" x 6.5", after iron on SAS, subcut twice on diagonal
 - F. STEMS (1) 1.5" x WOF (no SAS)

BACKGROUND (4) 10" x 10" (no SAS)

II. PREP BACKGROUNDS

- 1. Iron and starch
- 2. Iron creases to find center.
- 3. Draw pattern on right side of fabric matching center. Use pencil, and draw on inside line.

III. PREP FABRIC

- 1. Use cutting instructions above. Draw template on paper-side of SAS
- 2. Label A, B, C, D, E, or F respectively.
- 3. PRESS SAS to wrong side of fabric
- 4. Cut out pieces on line (no seam allowance).

PHD Monthly Challenge

Clear out your Quilting Space with a challenge to finish those projects from long ago.

Bring along your PHDs to the April 1 meeting to declare it.

State what needs to be done to finish your project.

Attaching a binding only will NOT be accepted as part of the challenge. Finished items will allow you to be put into a draw to win a PRIZE.

Table runner sets, small/medium wall hanging etc = 1 draw
Large projects = 2 draw
The more projects finished, the more chances to win.

Projects must be at least 2 years or older.
