**TONI STEERE'S WORKSHOP SUPPLY LIST:**

- Sewing machine, neutral thread
- Pre-wind 2 bobbins
- Basic sewing notions, pins, seam ripper, scissors...etc!
- Iron & pressing mat
- Rotary cutter & Mat (18x24 is big enough)
- Ruler at least 18" long
- Flying Geese Ruler. I (Toni) prefer the ultimate flying geese ruler by creative grids but will demonstrate the wing clipper from Studio 180 designs.
- 4 1/2" Creative Grids SQ
- Lunch / water
- The kits come precut. Those choosing their own fabrics will need to precut.
- I (Toni) will have both the flying geese ruler and the 4 1/2" Creative grids rulers available for purchase the day of class. Members can try before they buy.Precut kit/pattern/backing \$60
- Precut kit/pattern \$50
- Pattern \$6
- Cutting instructions on p. 4 if not purchasing a kit.
