## JUNE CHALLENGE FACES



A small wall hanging no larger than 28" square. Pull colorful fabric from

your stash for the background. Next is to form your face. Fun to have  $\frac{1}{2}$  and  $\frac{1}{2}$  of different fabrics for the face. A nice size for the head would fill a  $8\frac{1}{2} \times 11$  piece of paper. Add a mouth, nose, and eyes along with a neck and you are almost there. The fun part is making hair or hats. Add to the background things that represent you and your hobbies on fabric. It is best to use a poster board and attach things with pins or if you use steam a seam II it usually sticks without ironing. Make sure you like it before you iron everything down. I will be showing examples of faces from the "The Quilt Show." If you are a star member, you can go to the forum and see all the faces that have been sent in to the show. I will have some tips and hints as we go along. Have fun with this and let yourself go.

## WORKSHOP JUNE 19, 9-3

Christmas Irish Chain Quilt 77 x 77

1 yard of dark green, 1 yard of light green, 1 yard of dark red, 1 yard of light red,  
1/4 of light red for sashing and holly block centers, can be same as other light red or another light red, 1/4 yard of yellow/gold and 3 1/2 yards of cream or white fabric for background.

From dark green cut 52 strips- $2\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ " and 26 strips- $2\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$ "

From light green cut 52 strips- $2\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ " and 26 strips- $2\frac{1}{2}$  by  $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

From dark red cut 24 squares  $6" \times 6"$

From light red cut 24 squares  $6" \times 6"$  and 49 squares  $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ "

From background cut 104 squares  $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ ", 52 strips  $2\frac{1}{2} \times 6"$ ,

60 strips  $2\frac{1}{2} \times 13\frac{1}{2}$ " (sashing strips) and 24 strips  $2" \times 10\frac{1}{2}"$  and 24 strips  $2" \times 13\frac{1}{2}"$ .

## 2021 CHARITY PROJECT FOCUS

1. Honor Flight Quilts
2. Quilt of Valor Charity Blocks-- Eight-Point Floating Star and Floating Wonky Star. Three blocks equal one Charity Project. Completed blocks may be turned in to Sherry Kay Schaffer at any meeting.
3. Christmas stockings for Palmyra Area Food Pantry- "Christmas in July." Our Charity committee encourages members to complete stocking donations by July 2021. Stockings may be turned in to Ann Foreman at any meeting. For those unable to make guild meetings, they may be dropped off at the Heibel home. Please include your name.
4. MOOG Center for Deaf Education in St. Louis- a fabric donation of a full  $1\frac{1}{2}$  yard piece of quilters cotton. It can be from your 'ugly' stash. Fabric will be used to make 'aprons' for clear face mask shields. The center uses 90 aprons daily. Place fabric donation in a zip-lock bag, including your name. Fabric donations may be made at guild meetings, dropped off at the Heibel home or at The Hickory Stick. Communicate your fabric donation to a Charity Committee member.
5. Charity project of guild members choice. Communicate your donation to a Charity Committee member to receive credit.
