MJ Kinman's Trunk Show & Workshop Descriptions

1-Session Workshop (approx. 4-5 hours)



“Bite-Size Gems”

This technique class is devoted to learning techniques to chart and piece a faceted design supplied by the instructor using freezer paper piecing techniques. Activities include:

- Prepare an 18” square freezer paper template.
- Transfer the mock-up design to the freezer paper by using a simple grid technique.
- Create a color palette.
- Code the facets in their template to designate position, color, and adjacency.
- Cut apart their freezer paper template and sort by color code.
- Iron freezer paper facets to their painted fabric according to the color codes.
- Cut the facets and organize them by section code.
- Learn techniques to piece facets.

Supply List:

- 36” length of freezer paper (standard 18” width); white or brown will work fine
- Colored pencils in the colors of the gem they want to create.
- Highlighter
- Regular pencils
- Ball point pen or permanent markers
- Eraser
- Bic Wite-Out tape or similar brand
- 18” ruler & Small ruler with a ¼” measurement
- Domestic sewing machine and thread assortment (neutrals or colors that match your fabrics)
- Scissors and rotary cutting tools (cutter and mat) Bring 2 rotary cutters if you want to cut paper with one and your fabric with another.
- Iron and ironing pad (or board)
- Fabric – Cotton solids or gradients. Let’s keep it simple and bring one or two colors, but include a range of values within each color. This project works best when you have a very dark value, a very light value, and a range of 2 or 3 medium values. White and black also work well to bump up the “bling” in your gem.

MJ Kinman will share a slide lecture and trunk show. She’ll discuss the techniques to create and assembly the hundreds of pieces in each diamond, materials used to create

the wash of color and light across a gem’s surface, and the quilting techniques that enhance a gem’s facets. And, as so often happens with any artist’s decades-long journey, she’ll share what she’s learned about the importance of choosing joy and saying “no” to fear as she has in making the leap from the Corporate Life to the Creative Life.
