SOMETHING STITCHED
SHARON WASTENEY**

From one thread available to our quilting ancestors to the current plethora of thread choices afforded today's quilters, there are many options for finishing quilts. After sharing a brief history of threads used in quilts of the past, Sharon Wastenev will share samples of some of the many decorative and utilitarian threads available for quilters today with tips on their use in quilts. If you have used decorative threads in your quilting, please consider bringing for show and tell during the presentation.

UPCOMING PROGRAMS

August program will feature a presentation by Amy Jackson, owner of Salty Hippo Studio in Chilicothe, MO. Amy designs and prints quilting cottons in addition to other textiles. We might even see a preview of her exclusive fabric design for the All Missouri Shop Hop.

In September we'll host Ilene Bartos, quilt designer from Urbandale, Iowa for a trunk show centered around color theory. She will be teaching a class Wednesday following the meeting.
