SEWING AND FELLOWSHIP

Come sew on meeting day. The room will be available from 10:00 until around 4:00 on the day of our meeting.

UPCOMING PROGRAMS

August program will feature a presentation by Amy Jackson, owner of Salty Hippo Studio in Chilicothe, MO. Amy designs and prints quilting cottons in addition to other textiles. We might even see a preview of her exclusive fabric design for the All Missouri Shop Hop.

In September we'll host Ilene Bartos, quilt designer from Urbandale, Iowa for a trunk show centered around color theory. She will be teaching a class Wednesday following the meeting. This will be a great opportunity to learn some new quilting techniques, use of threads, and learn an innovative way to hang small quilts. It's very possible you'll go home with a small art quilt quilted.



FALL LEAF:

Learn how to enhance a simple leaf shape with fun techniques. Techniques in this class include: raw-edged appliqué, satin stitching, herky-jerky quilting, foiling, beading, and making a copper wire hanger. Your choice of six leaf patterns (13"x14"ish).

Kits which include the copper wire hanger will be available on the day of the class. You will also select your pattern on class day. Cost of the kit is \$55 and the pattern is \$10 (plus tax). You may also use your own fabrics. A supply list will be available next month.

Registration of \$30 will open at the July 11 meeting and payment is due at the time of registration. There will be no refunds but you are welcome to find someone to take your place.
