JULY 18 WORKSHOP

Barb Bier will help members make a Disappearing Shoofly quilt from Missouri Star Quilt Company as well as a "bonus" quilt.

Fabric supplies needed:

- 1 pack of 10" squares (Layer Cake) or 4-5" charm packs
 - 6 packs of 5" charm packs for background or 4¼ yards of fabric cut into 5" squares totaling 240 squares
 - 1½ yards fabric for borders
 - ¾ yard for binding
- Workshop is from 9-3 either at Park United or Holy Family Church.

(Doors will be open at 8:30 to allow time for setup)

We still have a couple more openings. Toni is bringing extra kits so it is not too late!!
Please pay for kits/patterns /rulers day of workshop.
If you are not purchasing a kit, **please be sure that your fabric is precut before workshop.**
Because of time limitations, Toni ask that we bring our lunch or have food delivered.

Toni's Supply List:

- Sewing machine, neutral thread
(pre-wind 2 bobbins)
- Extension cord/reel
- Small personal light (lighting may be a little dim)
- Basic sewing notions, pins, seam ripper, scissors...etc!
- Iron /pressing mat
- Rotary cutter/ Mat 18 x 24 is big enough
- Ruler at least 18" long
- Flying Geese Ruler (I prefer the ultimate flying geese ruler by creative grids but will demonstrate the wing clipper from Studio 180 designs)
- 4 1/2" creative grids SQ
- Lunch / water

Toni will have both the flying geese ruler and the 4 1/2" Creative grids rulers available for purchase the day of class. Ladies can try before they buy.

The kits come precut, ladies choosing their own fabrics will need to precut according to the following directions.

Cutting Instructions for *Toni's Tips, Tricks & Techniques in London Blues*

For easy identification label and pin like sizes together put each color in a small zip lock bag.
