August program will feature a presentation by Amy Jackson, owner of Salty Hippo Studio in Chilicothe, MO. Amy designs and prints quilting cottons in addition to other textiles. We might even see a preview of her exclusive fabric design for the All Missouri Shop Hop.

In September we'll host llene Bartos, quilt designer from Urbandale, Iowa for a trunk show centered around color theory. She will be teaching a class Wednesday following the meeting. This will be a great opportunity to learn some new quilting techniques, use of threads, and learn an innovative way to hang small quilts. It's very possible you'll go home with a small art quilt quilted.

FALL LEAF CLASS, SEPTEMBER 6, 2024

With Ilene Bartos we will explore a number of ways to enhance your choice of six simple leaf shapes. Techniques include Satin Stitching, Herky-Jerky Quilting, Foiling, Beading, and making the unique Copper Hangers which then can be applied to other quilting projects. Six different leaf patterns are available to choose from and are \$10 each. They will be available at the September meeting as well as at class Wednesday, September 6.

Supply List for Ilene's Fall Leaf Class

- Sewing machine with zigzag and normal attachments including open toe foot and darning or free motion quilting foot
- Black thread
- Variegated Thread for leaf veins (Sharon will have many choices for class participants to use if you don't have)
- Thread to coordinate with background fabric, border fabric and leaf fabric
- Rotary cutter, mat, ruler
- Scissors (fabric and paper)
- Applique pressing cloth or parchment paper (Sharon will have parchment paper for student use)
- Marking chalk or pencil
- Freezer paper, approx. 12" x 12"
- Stabilizer, approx. 12" x 12"
- Batting, approx. 18" x 18"
- Fat quarter for backing
- Spray Adhesive like KK2000 (Sharon has to share)
- 12 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" square ruler for trimming

Also: Kits will include the following for \$55 or you can bring your own:

- Four fat quarters of coordinating fabric for background, leaf, borders, binding
- Black fabric approx., 12" x 12" for leaf
- Foil in copper color
- Beads in copper color, beading needle, beading thread (Sharon will have many beads for student use)
- Small amount of fusible web (Misty Fuse or Soft fuse work well)
- Copper tubing, 1/2" x 14"
- Copper wire 18 gauge, 12 ½ feet

Total cost for kit and pattern is \$65. Beads/foils/threads/copper kits will all be available at class.

It's almost time again for the Salt River Quilt Show. It's coming up a little quicker this year, on the weekend of September 16 and 17. Entries will be due the 8th of September, and quilts will be hung on September 14 and judged on the 15th. As in prior shows, Marianne Bodine will be glad to pick quilts up at the guild meeting on September 5 if you wish to enter any, and will see that they are returned safely if you cannot pick them up on the 17th. The theme of the show and primary quilt category is "Seasons of Our Lives," in the sense of the stages in life we go through from childhood to adulthood, our careers, our families, our travels, our major life events. Other categories this year are "Hand-Pieced or Hand-Quilted", "Other Quilted Items" (clothing, purses or bags, Christmas tree skirts, table or bed runners, etc.), "Small Quilts (baby quilts, miniatures, small wall-hangings, doll quilts, etc.), and, as always, "Miscellaneous Quilts" for those that don't fit elsewhere.
