WORKSHOP AUGUST 15



Fabric Requirements for **TWO** bags:
2 fat quarters of coordinating fabrics (or you may use up to 4 fabrics)

1/4 yard of fusible fleece
2 -- 14" zippers
2 -- 4" x 6 1/2" pieces of heavy vinyl
(I will provide the vinyl.)

If you want to cut your fabrics in advance cut the following if you want to make TWO bags:

MAIN FABRIC

2 -- 8" x 9 1/2" -- Back of bag
2 -- 6" x 9 1/2" -- Bottom of window
2 -- 4" x 9 1/2" -- Top of window (or could use fabric 3)
4 -- 4" x 4" -- Sides of window (or could use fabric 4)
2 -- 2 1/4" x 12" -- Handle
2 -- 1 1/2" x 4" -- Zipper end cover

LINING FABRIC

2 -- 8" x 9 1/2" Rectangle

FUSIBLE FLEECE

2 -- 8" x 9 1/2" -- Back of bag
4 -- 1 1/2" x 4" -- Side of bag
2 -- 1 1/2" x 9 1/4" -- Top of bag
2 -- 2 1/2" x 9 1/4" -- Bottom of bag

December 2020 Challenge



Noted

Must include words on front of quilt.

Pull fabric from your stash or a friend's stash that has words on it. Suggestions – Note to self, conversation hearts, music lyrics, sayings, sewing quotes, kitchen quotes or recipes just to name a few.

Quilt may be started before 2019 but must be FINISHED in 2020.

Quilt may be any size and must be 2-3 layers. No bags or clothing please. Quilt must include some piecing and quilting. Piecing/quilting may be any technique. Finished Edge does not have to be bound traditionally. Embellishments are optional.

Quilt back must include a hanging sleeve and label made according to the guidelines of the HPQG quilt show rules.

On a 3' x 5' index card please tell us what inspired you to make this quilt. Did your fabric come from a friend's stash? Does your quilt have a special story? Tell us if you tried a new technique or used any special techniques?

Entries should be kept secret. Please cover up your label with a piece of paper or fabric before handing it in to the program committee at the meeting.

Due Date: Finished challenges are due at our December 2020 meeting.
