If you are still making masks and need elastic, we will have a roll of 180 yards of 1/4-inch white elastic at the September meeting for anyone who needs some.

Other projects are the Christmas stockings for the Food Pantry in Palmyra. Our goal is 200 and 26 have been turned in. Two stockings equal one project. The food pantry serves Palmyra, Philadelphia and limited service for Hannibal. This is a good way to use those batting scraps or you can also use fusible fleece. The stockings are filled by the pantry and given to children from birth to 18 years. The pattern is on the facebook page under files. We will also have some at the meeting.

Please keep making the Quilt of Valor 9-patch blocks. To date, 147 blocks have been turned in. Our goal is 300. Three blocks equal one project. These need to be turned in by the November meeting. #### MAGIC STARS TABLE RUNNER

21½" x 57½"

Materials Needed

- 1 3/8 yards total assorted multi-colored material (blocks)
  - 1 yard white tone on tone (blocks and table runner top)
  - 1/2 yard multicolored (binding)
  - 1 7/8 yards backing fabric
- CUT FABRIC BEFORE WORKSHOP

Assorted colors:

25--3½" squares

200--2" squares

White tone on tone:

108--3½" squares

Multicolored binding:

5--2½" x 42" strips
