WORKSHOP -- PARK UNITED METHODIST CHURCH -- 9 A.M. - 3 P.M.

SEPTEMBER 18 WORKSHOP--HARVEST TIME

Finished size 58½" x 72½"



Materials needed:

- 40 strips 2½" x 42" or assorted prints for blocks (you can use a jelly roll).
- 2 7/8 yards of white fabric for background
- ¾ yard of print for cornerstones and binding

Cutting from the 40 assorted print strips:

Cut 3 rectangles 2½" by 13½" from each strip (120 total).

From the white background fabric:

- Cut 37 strips 2½" x 42", crosscut into 320 squares 2½" x 2½" and 49 rectangles 2½" x 12½"

Cut 9 strips 2½" x 42" for binding and crosscut 2 of those strips into 30 squares 2½" x 2½" for cornerstones.

Please have your fabric cut before the workshop.
