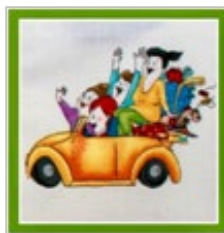

OCTOBER 11 WORKSHOP
FAT EIGHTH FLAPJACKS
SUE WINKING

Beacon United Methodist Church
 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.



We will be working on a Pattern from Fat Quarter Shop called Fat Eighth Flapjacks. The size we will be using is 60 x 70.

Fabric requirements are:

22 - 9" x 20" rectangles
 2 yds background
 3/4 yard for binding

Cutting:

Cut each fat eighth into 6 - 3" x 8" rectangles - 132 total.

Cut the background into 96 - 3" squares and 7 - 5½" width of fabric strips for the borders.

Cut the binding fabric into 8 - 2½" width of fabric strips.

The pattern is a free downloadable pattern from Fat Quarter Shop and has other size options if you want to make it another size. You can also watch a video on it on YouTube before the workshop to get familiar with what we are making.

Bring your own lunch or go out and get something to eat. We usually eat together. Members are always welcome to come and work on their own projects. Sue Winking
