Donations of quilting cotton fabric in cuts of 1 1/2 yard increments are being collected for the MOOG Center for Deaf Education in St. Louis. The fabric will be used to make aprons for the mask/shields that have been found to give the best hearing for these children while still protecting them from the virus.

--Daily, 90 aprons are needed for the audiologists, speech therapists and educators who work with these at-risk children, infant through 1st grade.



--Within a 75 mile radius of Hannibal, 28 children have been served by the Moog Center in the last 5-10 years.

--In Missouri students/alumni: Eolia, High Hill, Laddonia, Lagrange, Louisiana, Mexico, Montgomery City, Moscow Mills, Palmyra, Perry, Philadelphia, Silex, Troy, Wellsville and Winfield.
