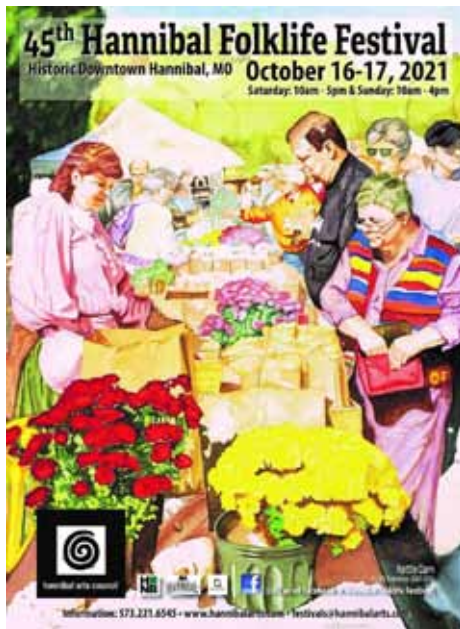
#### WEAVE PILLOW -- GINA JANES
