Look in your stash or purchase 3 fabrics that coordinate--a large print, light print and medium to dark print. Bring a ruler that you will be able to cut across the fabric and a 10’ ruler. Remember, you can always work on your own project rather than what we are doing.

ANNOUNCING THE 2025 SERIES QUILT

We are ready to go! A guild series quilt is an opportunity to work on the same project together but using our own personal fabric choices.

Committee members will show the finished block(s) each month and then give participants a monthly assignment. The following month, members will show their blocks and then receive the next month's assignment. We also plan to have work time for the Series Quilt during some of the monthly guild workshops.

Pattern: *A Quilting Life BOM 2022* by Sherri McConnell. If you want to participate and would like to purchase a paper colored copy, please let us know! We are working with the pattern author and anticipate the pattern costing \$15 each. There will be a sign up sheet to order the pattern and pre-pay at the December guild meeting. If you miss out on ordering a paper copy, you can buy the pattern from the designer and then print it yourself. It is 34 color pages.



The pattern includes 12 blocks bordered by churn dash frames in 6" and 12" finished sizes along with finishing instructions for two quilts in these sizes:

- 31" x 38" using the 6" blocks
- 51" x 65" using the 12" blocks

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS FOR 12" FINISHED BLOCKS

12 to 18 Fat Quarters (or more for a scrappier quilt)

2 yards of background fabric for blocks and inner border (solid or tone on tone)

1 yard contrast for the churn dash (designer used 1/3 yard each of three different gray prints)

1/2-yard sashing (designer used a light floral)

1-yard outer border

5/8-yard binding

3 1/2 -yards backing

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS FOR 6" FINISHED BLOCKS

12-18 Fat Eighths

1 yard of background fabric for blocks and inner border (solid or tone on tone)

1/2-yard contrast for the churn dash

1/4-yard sashing

1/2-yard outer border

1/3-yard binding

1 1/4 -yards backing
